The Agape Village Health Center, our latest expansion completed in February 2024, is a national model of integrated care, increasing our capacity to serve 2,500 individuals and families receiving monthly residential inpatient and outpatient services. Our state-of-the-art center is located in South Miami-Dade and embodies industry-leading standards in healthcare.

Our 80,000-square-foot community health center prioritizes holistic wellness, offering a 110-bed residential treatment program, transitional supportive housing and specialized treatment programs. This comprehensive facility ensures that every individual receives top-tier, value-based, quality care in a supportive environment, addressing diverse needs through an integrated approach.

Our innovative campus blends behavioral healthcare, education, faith and support services. We offer more than just medical care — we help individuals discover their own potential through vocational training, supportive housing and family-centered programs. Green spaces, including a community garden and nursery, offer a refreshing backdrop for healing. From the early learning center facilities to Mommy and Me inpatient residential quarters, we ensure families stay together while nurturing each individual's full potential.
